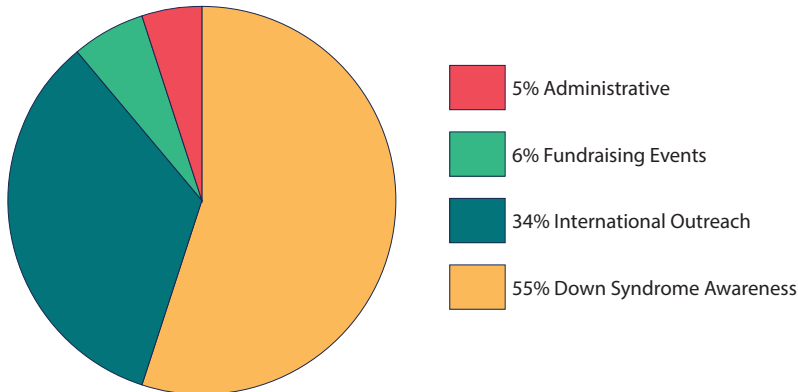

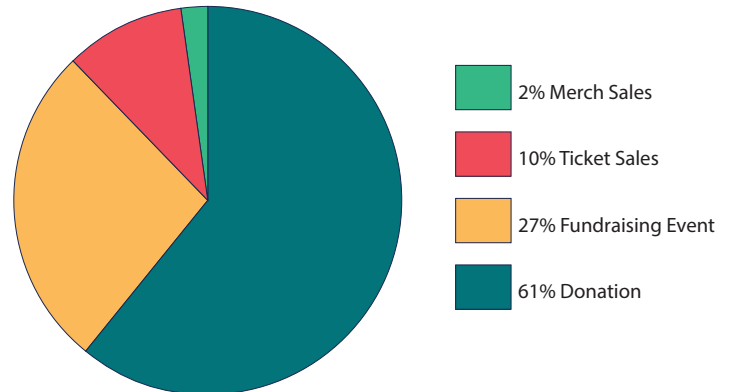
Breakdown of Expenses
